

N.B The fees below are a guide only and a higher fixed fee may be quoted depending upon complexity and individual circumstances. Factors that may affect the fees quoted include the number of Applicants, whether it is a first application or an extension, whether there have been previous immigration issues or refused applications.

Further additional fees may be charged in addition to the fixed fee quoted if additional unanticipated work is required. Additional fees will usually be dealt with by way of a further fixed fee and you will be informed in advance if additional fees will be likely.

*** THE FEES BELOW DO NOT INCLUDE HOME OFFICE APPLICATION FEES, NHS SURCHARGES, TRIBUNAL FEES OR DISBURSEMENTS SUCH AS INTERPRETER FEES, TRANSLATION FEES, EXPERT FEES, DNA testing - details about those can be found below the table of fees***

What's included?

The above prices include an initial consultation and assessment of the case, advice upon the Immigration Rules in question, the merits of an application and timelines involved, evidence required, application process, preparation of application form, assistance with submission of the application, arranging a biometric enrolment appointment where necessary and correspondence in relation to outcome of decision. Should an application be unsuccessful additional fees would be payable for any work relating to appeal or reconsideration of a decision.

Timescales

Upon initial instruction we will assess your case and how to proceed. We will usually give details of the information and documentation to proceed within two weeks of instruction. Once you have provided all the necessary information an application can usually be prepared and submitted to the Home Office within two weeks. Once submitted it is a question of waiting for a Home Office decision which can take between 8 weeks and 6 months but sometimes more in complex matters. The Home Office offers a priority service for an additional Home Office fee for some applications. For applications from within the UK this can result in a decision within a week. For applications from outside the UK this can mean a decision within 6-8 weeks.

Disbursements

Disbursements are not included in the above fees. Below are examples of Disbursements but this is not an exclusive list. Prices vary as these disbursement relate to services provided by independent third parties.

Disbursements are not incurred without prior agreement. Fees for agreed disbursements must be provided in advance.

VAT at the rate of 20% applies to disbursements where the Third Party Provider is VAT registered.

Examples of possible disbursements (prices may vary depending upon provider)

- Translations (cost depends upon size of document and starts from £40+VAT)
- DNA testing (cost depends upon number and location of individuals to be tested but start from about £400 +VAT).
- Country Expert Reports (cost depends upon hourly rate of expert and hours involved and vary widely from around £500 to £2000+. Some are liable for VAT where the expert is VAT registered)
- Interpreters (average cost of £27.50 per hour)

- the number of hours needed will vary on the complexities of the case and number of attendances necessary
- an average case would require about 4 hours of interpreting (£82.50)
- You do not always have to use an interpreter of the firm's choosing but can bring your own interpreter or someone to assist you with language. Should you use a person of your own choosing we cannot be held responsible if they do not fully interpret what we or you are saying

Home Office Fees etc.

Home Office Fees, NHS surcharges and Immigration Tribunal Fees are NOT included and are updated regularly.

Immigration Tribunal Fees

£140 oral hearing or £80 for a paper hearing

When will payments be required?

- Once you have confirmed that you wish to instruct us to act on your behalf we will require an initial deposit towards your costs and disbursements of £200.00 (exclusive of VAT)
- One-off advice appointment fees are payable on the day of the appointment
- Costs for disbursements such as translation fees, DNA testing fees must be provided in advance of such services being requested
- If you require us to provide an interpreter for an appointment you must provide the fee for that at least 7 days prior to the appointment. The usual rate would be £27.50 per hour unless the language required is more unusual and the price would be confirmed once availability is confirmed
- The balance of outstanding fees are to be provided at the time of submission of application
